



## East Bridgford King Edward Snooker Club

Interested in playing snooker? Why not come along to the King Edward Snooker Club located behind the Village Hall on Main Street, East Bridgford

There are few villages of our size that can boast their very own snooker club with a full size table. The king Edward club, according to our earliest records, was established during the reign of Edward VII and has been in continuous use for around 120 years.

Membership is open to residents of East Bridgford and surrounding villages. The only caveat is that junior members (under the age of 18) must be accompanied by an adult member.

The current membership fee is £15.00 a calendar year, plus a £10.00 deposit for a set of keys. A pro-rata membership fee applies for new members joining after January. A coin meter operates the table lights at a cost of £1.50 per hour.
